#### **Matthew Borowick:**

The Court-Martial of Fitz John Porter, a Civil War Round Table Handbook. The Civil War had its share of heroes and its share of men to whom blame for defeat or disaster. A union defeat at Manassas in the summer of 1862 lead to criticism and a court-martial for one of the rising stars of the Army of the Potomac's high command. Fingers were quickly pointed toward Major General Fitz John Porter, who did not perform as had expected. Porter spent nearly 24 years of his life trying to clear his name.

We will hear a wonderful presentation, rarely discussed but incredibly fascinating on the events of the Union loss at the Second Manassas, and the downfall of one of the most skillful generals

Our speaker is a lifelong Civil War history buff. He has served as the General E.

Lee Civil War Round Table of Central Jersey newsletter editor, advisory board member, and webmaster! Moreover, he helped establish the Civil War Library and Research Center and was its first Executive Director. In 2010 he authored and published *The Civil War Round Table Handbook- The Indispensable Guide to Running Yours Right*. We are so happy to have him to have him speak at our own Civil War Round Table; you won't want to miss an excellent speaker.

How about our last meeting at the Delaplaine Center, what a success!! Thanks to all who helped out on this and to all that attended.


Great turn-out, I counted about one hundred fifty or so. The November meeting, will of course be back at the National Museum of Civil War Medicine.
